Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for the following programmes scheduled to start in **March 2023**:

- (a) Master of Philosophy in **Education**, MPhil (ME) Programme – **Full-time**
- (b) Master of Philosophy in **Education**, MPhil (ME) Programme – **Part-time**
- (c) Master of Philosophy in **Mathematics Education**, MPhil (ME) Programme – **Full-time**
- (d) Master of Philosophy in **Mathematics Education**, MPhil (ME) Programme – **Part-time**

Minimum Admission Requirements:

- (i) 2nd Class Honours degree or above in the relevant field, which includes a dissertation/research project;
- (ii) Either a Master's degree in a related field with a substantial research component;
 - or a post graduate award which includes completion of a research project;
 - or evidence of research experience;
 - or professional experience which can be considered as equivalent in terms of research skills acquired and capacity for independent work.

Note: Acceptable qualifications for entry at any level must be recognised by relevant bodies (Mauritius Qualifications Authority/Government Examination Boards/Regulatory bodies, UK NARIC, etc.)

Duration of Course:

- (i) Full-time: 15 months
- (ii) Part-time: 30 months

Fees:

Rs 100, 000 (whole programme), payable at time of registration

Programme Details:

The programme (HEC accredited) aims to develop frontier theoretical, methodological and applied knowledge in a chosen area/field by developing capacities to independently conceive, design and complete a research undertaking in a chosen area using appropriate methodologies, tools, skills and techniques in a reflective, ethical and critical way. The programme targets primarily professionals and academics in education who aspire to engage in doctoral research. Through an appropriate balance of specialist content, general conceptual skills and personal transferable skills, the programme offers advanced standing on professional doctorates in education (Ed.D.) and Ph.D. in Education with current MIE international partners.

Programme Delivery:

Sessions will be run using a blended approach of synchronous, using face to face and asynchronous online contact. The programme is delivered by qualified and adequately credentialed tutors with doctoral completions and robust publications track record in education and related fields. Faculty from a range of MIE's partnering international institutions also teach on the programme.

Mode of Application:

Applications must be made online through the MIE website: <http://apply.mie.mu>. Once the applications are submitted, the **Declaration Form** has to be printed and signed to certify acceptance of the Terms and Conditions stipulated in the programme. The duly signed form, along with your Research proposal (as per template available on the MIE Website) should be sent to the **Office of the Registrar, MIE, Réduit**, at latest by **Tuesday 14 March 2023 at 15 00**.

The course applied for should be clearly indicated at the top left-hand corner of the envelope.

Applications not received as per the modality described above will not be considered.
