The 2022 edition of the research week was held at MIE from 8th to 10th November 2022. This edition aimed to consolidate on the previous editions of the research week by providing a broader platform to accommodate not only paper presentations and keynote address, but it also included capacity building sessions for our early researchers. Thus, besides the presentations of research findings, there were sessions related to conceptualising research proposals in an ethical framework, elaborating a budget proposal to apply for funding and grants, supervising postdoctoral research thesis and working out a plan for research for the year 2023 and beyond. An online keynote speech was given by Dr A Colman from the University of London Institute of Education on “The transformative power of research-informed practices in teacher education. Oral presentations focused on a diversity of concepts including core qualities of pedagogy, holistic education, feedback mechanisms, quality assurance, curriculum/course design, technology embedded teaching and learning, pedagogy of learners with intellectual disabilities, teacher agencies in the time of change. The outcomes of the research week have contributed to frame a plan of action to enhance the research culture and ambiance at the MIE.
