Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for the following programmes scheduled to start in **July 2024**:

FULL-TIME PROGRAMME

1. PROFICIENCY CERTIFICATE IN SPECIAL EDUCATION

(For pre-service candidates intending to join Special Education Needs Institutions)

Minimum Admission Requirement:

- Five passes at SC/GCE 'O' level including English Language **Or**
- A certificate in RPL (SEN) Level 3

Duration of Course: One Year (2 semesters)

Fees payable at the time of registration: Rs 2050

1. Registration Fee: Rs 1000
2. Library Fee: Rs 500
3. IT Fee: Rs 500
4. Student Union Fee: Rs 50

Note:

Students will be required to obtain a First Aid Certificate from a certified provider identified by the MIE against payment of a fee as prescribed by the service provider.

PART-TIME PROGRAMMES

1. BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (SECONDARY) - B.Ed (Hons)

(For practising Secondary Educators, who are HSC holders & holders of a Degree in a subject area not taught at School - To be considered on a case to case basis)

Main Fields of Study:

- (xvii) Asian Languages (Hindi, Marathi, Modern Chinese, Tamil, Telugu, Urdu)*
(xviii) Arabic

***ASIAN LANGUAGES** will be offered in collaboration with Mahatma Gandhi Institute (MGI).

Minimum Admission Requirements:

1. (a) A Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least 5 subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings; or
(b) Passes not below Grade C in at least 5 subjects including English Language obtained at not more than 2 sittings at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level"; provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either;
 - (i) in 5 subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any 2 subjects; or
 - (ii) in 6 subjects, including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject;
 - (iii) where credit is not obtained in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate passes in at least two subjects at "Advanced Level" and at least two subjects at "Subsidiary Level" including General Paper obtained at one sitting at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.
2. A Cambridge Higher School Certificate or Passes in at least 2 subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level"; and
3. A degree or joint degree, or an equivalent qualification.

Note:

- At least one subject at 'A' Level should be relevant to the Main Field of Study applied for, except for Kreol Repiblik Moris, Food Studies, Design and Textiles Studies, History and Geography.
- For Food Studies, an 'A' Level in any Science subject (Biology, Chemistry or Physics) will also be acceptable.
- For Design & Textiles Studies, an 'A' Level in Art & Design, Design and Technology or Chemistry will also be acceptable.
- For Kreol Repiblik Moris, candidates should have either English or French at 'A' level.

Duration of Course: Three Years (6 Semesters)

Yearly Fees: (i) Rs 4,550 or (ii) Rs 7,550 (Rs 3000 representing fees for Specialised Room/Laboratory)

1. Registration Fee: Rs 3,500
2. Library Fee: Rs 500
3. IT Fee: Rs 500
4. Student Union Fee: Rs 50

*Specialised Room/ Laboratory Fee: (Applicable for *Art and design, Design and Textiles Studies, Food Studies, Design and Technology, Biology, Chemistry and Physics*)

Semester Fee: Tuition Fee: Rs 15,000/-

Note: *The Tuition Fee amounting to Rs 15,000 per semester will be paid by government for those candidates attempting an undergraduate degree for the first time, in line with the government policy pertaining to Free Tertiary Education Scheme (Ref: MTE/CR/198). However, those who already possess a degree will be required to pay the tuition fee.*

2. TEACHER'S DIPLOMA IN EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

*(For practising Pre-Primary Educators both in **Mauritius & Rodrigues**)*

Minimum Admission Requirements:

- (i) Five Passes at SC/GCE 'O' level including English Language;
- (ii) A Certificate of Proficiency in Early Childhood Education (CPECE) and Teacher's Certificate Pre-Primary (TCPP) / Teacher's Certificate in Early Childhood Education (TCECE); and
- (iii) At least 4 years post TCPP/TCECE teaching experience.

or

- (i) Five Credits at SC/GCE 'O' level including English Language;
- (ii) A Teacher's Certificate Pre-Primary (TCPP) or Early Childhood Education - Teacher's Certificate (ECETC); and
- (iii) At least 4 years post TCPP/ECETC teaching experience.

Duration of Course: 2 Years (4 semesters)

Yearly Fee: Rs 3,550/- is payable at the time of registration

1. Registration Fee: Rs 2,500

3. PROFICIENCY CERTIFICATE IN SPECIAL EDUCATION

(For Educators/ Assistant Educators practising in Special Education Needs Schools)

Minimum Admission Requirement:

Candidates are required to:

- have studied up to Form 3 and have at least 3 years of proven practice/ experience in SEN sector
Or
- have completed a Foundation Course in Special Education or hold a certificate in RPL (SEN) Level 3.

Note:

Applicants should have adequate access to a SEN setting throughout the duration of the programme.

Duration of Course: One-and-a-half Years (3 semesters)

Fee payable at the time of registration: Rs 2050

1. Registration Fee: Rs 1000
2. Library Fee: Rs 500
3. IT Fee: Rs 500
4. Student Union Fee: Rs 50

Delivery of Classes at the MIE:

- *Full-Time courses are normally run from 09 00 to 16 00 on weekdays and 09 00 to noon on Saturdays. Students may also be required to follow courses from 15 30 to 18 30 during weekdays and on Saturday afternoons.*
- *Part-Time courses are run from 16 00 to 19 00 during weekdays and 09 00 to noon on Saturdays. In exceptional circumstances, students may be required to follow courses on Saturday afternoons.*
- *Courses may be offered face-to-face, online, on a distance mode or on a split basis, or with a combination of any of those modalities. As such, students should make the necessary arrangements for personal device and Internet connectivity, and ensure that they conduct all the activities as specified in the Programme Handbook/ Module Information Sheets provided by the tutors.*

- Moreover, the MIE may resort to an online mode during bad weather conditions or in conditions that could hinder the normal face-to-face mode of delivery.
- The MIE reserves the right to make any further alteration to the duration of the programme, mode of delivery and assessment owing to any exigency that may occur in the future.

General Notes:

- (a) Online Applications should bear all relevant details as per the stipulated entry requirements since selection will be based solely on information provided online.
- (b) Qualifications obtained after the closing date will not be considered.
- (c) The best qualified candidates will be selected for the Full-Time and Part-Time programmes.
- (d) The onus for the submission of equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from relevant authorities in Mauritius (HEC or MQA) rests on the candidate.
- (e) Courses will be run subject to a **critical mass** is obtained in the respective subject areas and in the programme as a whole.
- (f) Candidates are required to follow only one course at a time at the MIE.
- (g) Only successful applicants will be notified of the outcome of their applications.
- (h) The MIE reserves the right not to run any of the above-mentioned courses nor will it assign any reason thereof.

Mode of Application:

Applications must be made online through the MIE website: <http://apply.mie.mu>. Once the applications are submitted, the **Declaration Form** has to be printed and signed to certify acceptance of the Terms and Conditions stipulated in the programme.

The form should be sent to the **Office of the Registrar, MIE, Réduit**, by **Monday 10 June 2024 at 15 00** at latest.

The course applied for should be clearly indicated at the top left-hand corner of the envelope.

Applications not received as per the modality described above will not be considered.
