## **Theory**

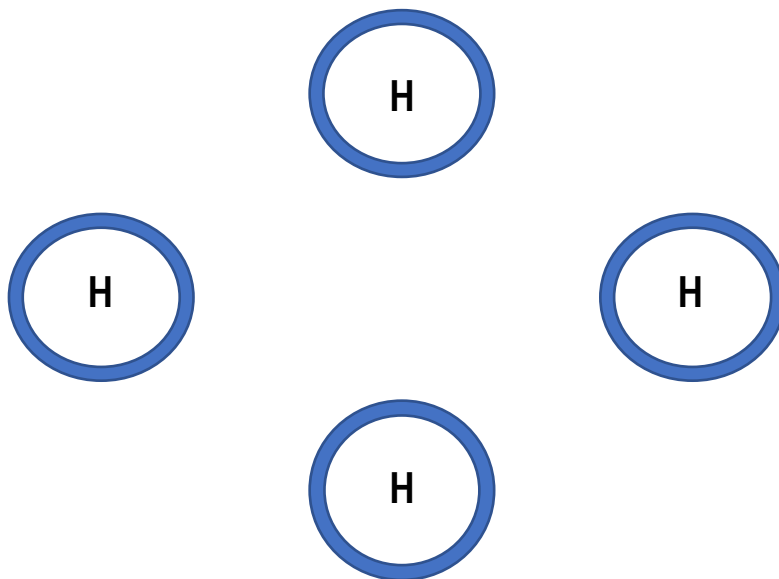
1. Your Nationality – how do you identify yourself?
