(A) Media exploration - stenciling

(paper folding to create simple designs)

(B) Competency, Element, and Performance Criteria

C 7.1: Creative Expression with stenciling - paper folding and paper cutting:
use paper folding and paper cutting to express ideas, feelings, and emotions creatively.

Performance Criteria:

Level 1

- Understand and use art elements and principles of design in creating patterns and designs through paper folding.

(C) Purpose of activity: This activity enables students to understand paper folding and paper cutting to create a simple stencil.

(D) Learning Outcomes

By the end of the lesson, students will be able to:

- understand art elements and principles of design.
- experiment with a paper folding technique to make simple stencils.

(E) Resources and materials:

A3-size paper, pencils, coloured pencils, wax crayons, eraser, spare stencils, round- tipped scissors, ruler, own visuals of simple motifs derived from environment

(F) Teaching Trajectories/Implementation guidelines

Activity 1:

- Carry out a recap of art elements and principles of design, motifs, patterns and design.
- Discuss how motifs and designs can be inspired by realistic patterns from the environment.
- Use your own visuals to explain how simple motifs can be developed by simplification of forms from the environment.
- Demonstrate on the board how motifs can be developed from flowers, leaves and any other elements from the environment.
- Draw a simple motif on paper.
- Demonstrate how to use this motif and paper folding and cutting to create stencil (s).
- Remind students about safety guidelines when handling scissors.
- Allow students to experiment with paper folding and cutting to create simple stencils.
- Monitor the classwork and provide individual attention and personal assistance as and when required.
- Ask students to create a simple motif on paper to be used for the next class.
- Collect the stencil to be used for the next class.

(G) Assessment

Carry out a formative evaluation to test the knowledge and understanding about the concepts taught.

(H) Extension of activity (further ideas)

Students can explore further ideas to make different stencils.
