  - Poster on Molly's Honey Time
  - Spinner
  - A dome headpin
  - Sentence cards





### Note to teacher for Activity 1:

Cut out the spinner and place it on the indicated spot on the poster. Use a dome headpin to secure the spinner in such a way that it spins smoothly.

### Teaching trajectories/ Implementation Guidelines



### **Activity 1: Molly's Honey Time**

- Show the poster 'Molly's Honey Time' to the students. Ask students
  to say what they can see in the different pictures on the poster. Help
  students to provide words like honey pot, basket, trees, flowers,
  butterfly and so on.
- 2. Introduce Molly, the butterfly, to students.
- 3. Ask students to compare Molly's position in the four pictures provided. Ask the question: Is Molly in the same place in the different pictures?
- 4. Cut out the spinner and secure it using a dome headpin in the middle of the poster.
- 5. For this activity, students work in groups of 4. Each student takes turns to spin the spinner. Ask the question: Where is Molly?
- 6. Introduce the prepositions **behind**, **next to** and **in front of** orally.
- 7. Cut out the sentence cards. Read and explain each sentence.
- 8. Encourage students to read and explain the sentences independently.
- 9. Students spin the spinner and select the correct sentence card for the picture on which they fall. They read aloud their answer.







### **Activity 2: Where is Molly?**

- 1. Provide the worksheet for Activity 2 to students.
- 2. Teacher asks students to observe Molly's positions in the picture.
- 3. Students write the correct prepositions in the spaces provided.
- 4. Students complete Activity 2. They use prepositions **behind**, **next to** and **in front of**, in the sentences provided.



### **Activity 3: Molly's Birthday Party**

- Students complete Activity 3 Part 1. They write sentences using prepositions behind, next to and in front of to describe the positions of the insects in the picture.
- 2. For Activity 3 Part 2, ask students to draw three insects, a bee, a spider and a grasshopper, around the birthday cake. Teacher guides students:
  - -Draw a grasshopper behind the cake.
  - -Draw a bee in front of the cake.
  - -Draw a spider next to the cake.
- 3. For Activity 3 Part 3, students write sentences to show the positions of the insects using the correct prepositions.
- 4. Students read their sentences in front of the class.
- G Assessment:

Use prepositions **behind**, **in front of** and **next to** orally and in writing.

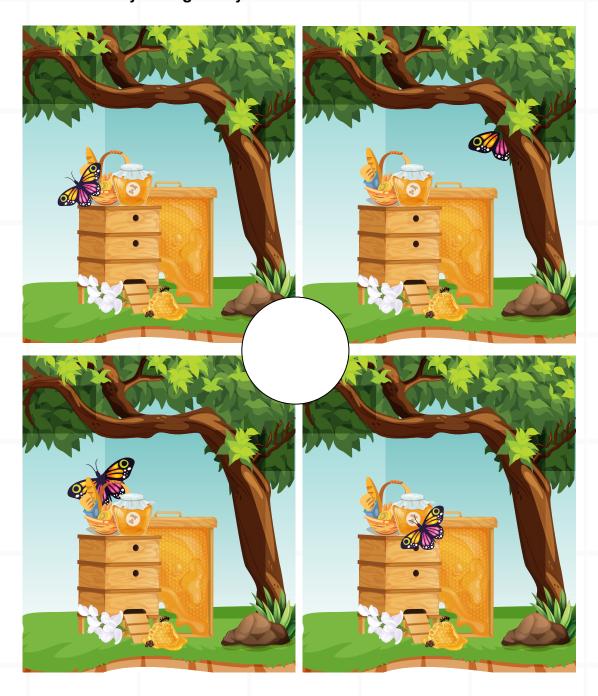
H Extension of activity:

### **Activity 1: Molly's Honey Time**

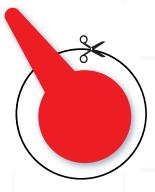
(i) It's honey time. Say what you see in the pictures. Where is Molly during honey time?





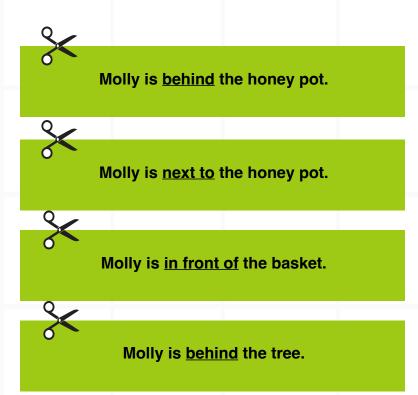


(ii) Cut and place the spinner in the middle of the poster.
