Articles - a and an

Competency: C1.5 Basic grammar

Element 1: Demonstrate understanding of grammar (articles)

Performance Criteria- Level 1: 1.6 Identify and use articles *a* and *an*

Purpose of activity: Students should be able to use article *a* and *an* in sentences.

Learning outcomes: By the end of the activity, students should be able to:

- identify when articles *a* and *an* are used.
- use articles *a* and *an* appropriately.

Resource and materials: pictures of four baskets, pictures of objects

Teaching trajectories / Implementation guidelines:

Activity 1: Let's go to Casela

- 1. Teacher reads the poem aloud together with the students.
- Teacher explains the usage of *a* and *an* in the poem.

Activity 2: A visit to a zoo

- 1. Teacher talks about the things that can be brought or cannot be brought to a zoo and writes the words on the board.
 - -Things that can be brought: water bottle, cap, phone, umbrella, apple, orange
 - -Things that cannot be brought: bed, apron, table, envelope, oven
- Teacher explains when to use *a* and *an*. (For example, use *a* with countable nouns starting with consonants and *an* with countable nouns starting with vowels).
- 2. Students cut the four pictures and place them in the correct basket.
- 3. Teacher asks students to draw objects discussed in class in the appropriate baskets.

Activity 3: A zoo mini-book

- 1. Teacher provides pictures from a zoo to be stuck in students' mini-books or asks them to draw what they can see at the zoo in their mini-books. (For example: pictures of different animals, fence, umbrella, cages, tree, restaurant, bench, etc.)
- Teacher helps students to write the words and guides them to use *a* or *an* in front of the words.
- 2. Students read their zoo mini-books aloud in front of the class.

Assessment: Write words with appropriate articles.

Extension of activity: Write sentences with appropriate articles.
