Identify Animal Names

Competency: Listening with understanding

Element: Understand basic spoken Arabic words

Performance Criteria:

• Listen to and understand meaning of common words

Purpose of Activity:

To enable students to recognise, read, and pronounce basic animal names in Arabic through visual association, oral repetition, and hands-on matching tasks.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- Recognise the Arabic names of common animals
- Match animal words to their pictures
- Pronounce basic animal names correctly
- Use basic Arabic vocabulary orally and in simple matching/cut-paste tasks

Teaching trajectories/ Implementation guidelines:

Activity 1:

Identify Animal Names

- 1. Show picture of animals
- 2. Say the name of each animal aloud in Arabic and ask students to repeat
- 3. Use Choral repetition, individual response and visual pointing

Activity 2:

Matching Words to Pictures

- 1. Hand out the matching worksheet
- 2. Guide students to read the Arabic word and draw a line to the correct animal image
- 3. Provide support as needed for decoding Arabic script

Activity 3:

Cut and paste

- 1. Students cut out the animals and paste them next to the correct Arabic names
- 2. Monitor correct matching and pronunciation during this hands on activity

Resources and materials:

Printed animal cards (with images and Arabic names), scissors and glue (for cut and paste)

Assessment:

Listening: Can students identify an animal name when you say it?

Reading: Can students read and match the Arabic names to the correct images?

Extension of activity:

Ask students to draw their favourite animal and label it in Arabic
