Identify Animal Names

Competency: Reading with comprehension

Element: Recognise and identify Arabic letters

Performance Criteria:

• Analyse words into sounds and letters

Purpose of Activity:

To enable students to identify, spell, and write basic animal names in Arabic using correct letters, through listening, reading aloud, and alphabet completion task.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- Identify individual letters in Arabic animal names
- Read aloud familiar animal names
- Spell out simple animal words in Arabic
- Complete partially written words using correct missing letter

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Teaching trajectories/ Implementation guidelines:

Activity 1:

Spell and read aloud

- 1. Display animal names written in syllabic form
- 2. Pronounce the words clearly and ask students to repeat each one
- 3. Encourage students to point and read aloud as a group and individually
- 4. Focus on syllable sound recognition and correct pronunciation

Activity 2:

Write the correct Alphabet

- 1. Hand out the worksheet with missing letters in animal names
- 2. Guide students in identifying the correct missing letter from a choice
- 3. Encourage them to say the full word once complete
- 4. Provide support in letter shape and sound recognition

Resources and materials:

Worksheet with alphabet choices for missing letters (visual aid), pencil for writing practice

Assessment:

Listening:

Can students correctly repeat the names after hearing them?

Reading:

Can students read the completed words aloud confidently?

Writing:

Can students identify and write the correct missing letters?

Extension of activity:

Ask students to write the names of two animals from memory
