Animal Names

Competency: Writing readiness

Element: Copy letters, common words and phrases

Performance Criteria:

• Copy common words with and without vowels

Purpose of Activity:

To help students recognise spell, trace, copy, and complete basic animal names in Arabic while improving handwriting and reading accuracy.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- Read familiar animal names in Arabic
- Spell animal names aloud
- Trace and copy Arabic words with correct shape and direction
- Complete animal names using correct missing letters

Teaching trajectories/ Implementation guidelines:

Activity 1:

Spell and read aloud

- 1. Present target animal names and read them aloud
- 2. Ask students to repeat and spell each word
- 3. Emphasise proper pronunciation and syllable segmentation

Activity 2:

Trace the words

- 1. Provide tracing worksheets for selected animal names
- 2. Demonstrate correct Arabic letter formation
- 3. Guide students to trace over the words

Activity 3:

Copy the words

- 1. Give students lined space to copy the traced animal names
- 2. Monitor handwriting and reinforce proper letter sizing and direction

Activity 4:

Write the correct alphabet

- 1. Distribute worksheets with animal names missing one letter
- 2. Provide letter options to choose from
- 3. Guide students to complete the word correctly

Resources and materials:

Worksheet for spelling, tracing, copying, and completing animal names, letter-choice strips for missing letter activity, pencil

Assessment:

Reading:

Can students read and recognise the animal names?

Writing:

Can students trace and copy words legibly?

Spelling:

Can students choose and write the correct missing letter?

Extension of activity:

Challenge students to write their favourite animal name from memory.
