Animal Names

Competency: Basic Grammar, Vocabulary and Sentence Structure

Element: Use given Arabic words to complete simple sentences

Performance Criteria:

• Use the given words to complete the sentences so that they make sense

Purpose of Activity:

To enable students to practice reading short Arabic sentences and completing them using familiar animal vocabulary, improving comprehension and sentene-level word recognition.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- Read short Arabic sentences aloud with understanding
- Identify missing animal names in simple contexts
- Use known vocabulary to complete sentence meaning
- Improve their reading accuracy and fluency

Teaching trajectories/ Implementation guidelines:

Activity 1:

Fill in the blanks

- 1. Read sample sentences aloud (with one word missing)
- 2. Guide students to guess and write the correct animal word from options
- 3. Encourage rereading of the complete sentence once the word is filled in
- 4. Use peer comparison to check answers

Activity 2:

Read the sentences

- 1. Provide full sentence strips using familiar vocabulary (e.g. الطير على الشجرة)
- 2. Ask students to read aloud individually or in groups
- 3. Ask comprehension questions based on the sentences (e.g., 'Where is the bird?')

Resources and materials:

Fill-in-the-blank sentence worksheet, pencils

Assessment:

Reading:

Can students read and understand full sentences with familiar vocabulary?

Word completion:

Can students select the correct animal name to complete the sentence?

Comprehension:

Can they explain or act out the meaning of the sentence?

Extension of activity:

Use a sentence scramble game (rearrange words to form a sentence)
