Animal Names

Competency: : Listening with understanding

Element: Form words from cluster of letters

Performance Criteria:

• Join letters together to form common words

Purpose of Activity:

To enable students to practice spelling and writing basic names in Arabic by blending letters, completing partial words, and copying correctly spelled vocabulary.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- Read and spell Arabic animal names aloud using letter-by-letter decoding
- Identify and write missing letters in animal words
- Copy animal names accurately with proper shape and letter spacing
- Reinforce word structure and confidence in Arabic script

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Teaching trajectories/ Implementation guidelines:

Activity 1:

Spell and practice

- 1. Present animal words broken into individual letters
- 2. Students sound out and blend letters to form complete words
- 3. Model pronunciation and spelling
- 4. Ask students to practice spelling both orally and in writing

Activity 2:

Complete the words

- 1. Provide worksheets with partially spelled animal names
- 2. Offer two-letter options for each blank
- 3. Students select the correct letter and complete the word
- 4. Encourage rereading of the completed word for reinforcement

Resources and materials:

Worksheet for spelling, blending, and completing animal names, pencils and erasers

Assessment:

Reading:

Can students decode and read the spelled animal names?

Spelling:

Can they form words from provided letters?

Writing:

Are they able to write full words clearly and accurately?

Extension of activity:

Play a 'Which letter is missing?' game on the board
