## **ADJECTIVES**

Competency C 1.5: Basic Grammar, Vocabulary and Sentence Structure

**Element 1:** Demonstrate understanding of grammar (adjectives).

Performance Criteria-Level 1:1.3 Use appropriate adjectives.

Purpose of activity: This activity will help students to understand and use adjectives in sentences.

**Learning outcomes:** By the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- recognise adjectives.
- choose the correct adjectives to describe a noun.
- use adjectives to write sentences.

**Resources and materials:** Worksheets

## **Teaching trajectories/ Implementation guidelines:**

#### Activity 1: 'Bring and Share' Day at Raina's School

- 1. Show the picture to the class and ask students what they can see.
- 2. Ask the following questions/prompts to introduce adjectives.
  - » Describe Raina. Talk about her appearance.
  - » Describe the other students.
  - » What is the shape of the table?
- 3. Add more questions to expose students to adjectives.

## Activity 2: The Adjectives Chart

- 1. Explain what is meant by adjectives and categorise them.
- 2. Show the Adjectives Chart to students and explain the adjectives provided.
- 3. Ask students to write more examples in each column. Provide support where required.

## NOTE TO TEACHER:

Help students add more adjectives to the list.

## Activity 3: Raina's Favourite Toppings

- 1. Show students the different food items. Ask students to identify them. Provide the names of the food items in case students need support; pizza, donut, popcorn, hot chocolate and ice cream.
- 2. Ask students to describe each food item orally, for example:
  - » What is the shape of the pizza slice?
  - » Is the ice-cream hot or cold?
  - » What is the colour of hot chocolate?
  - » Add more questions if required.
- 3. Explain the adjectives provided on each topping to the students.
- 4. Students cut and paste the adjectives toppings on the appropriate food items.
- 5. They read and explain the meaning of the adjective on each food item.

## Activity 4: Adjective Match

- 1. Divide the class into two groups. Group 1 is provided with picture cards and Group 2 with adjective cards.
- 2. Students from Group 2 read the adjectives on the cards while students in Group1 look for the corresponding pictures. Teacher provides feedback.

## Activity 5: Describe them!

- 1. Explain the activity to the students.
- 2. Ask students to write adjectives to describe the pictures. They can refer to the Adjectives Chart from Activity 1.
- 3. For the last activity, guide students to write five sentences using adjectives to describe the picture provided.

**Assessment:** Students write sentences using adjectives.

**Extension of activity:** Students write a descriptive paragraph using adjectives.
