Activity 1: The villain who tried to spoil Christmas

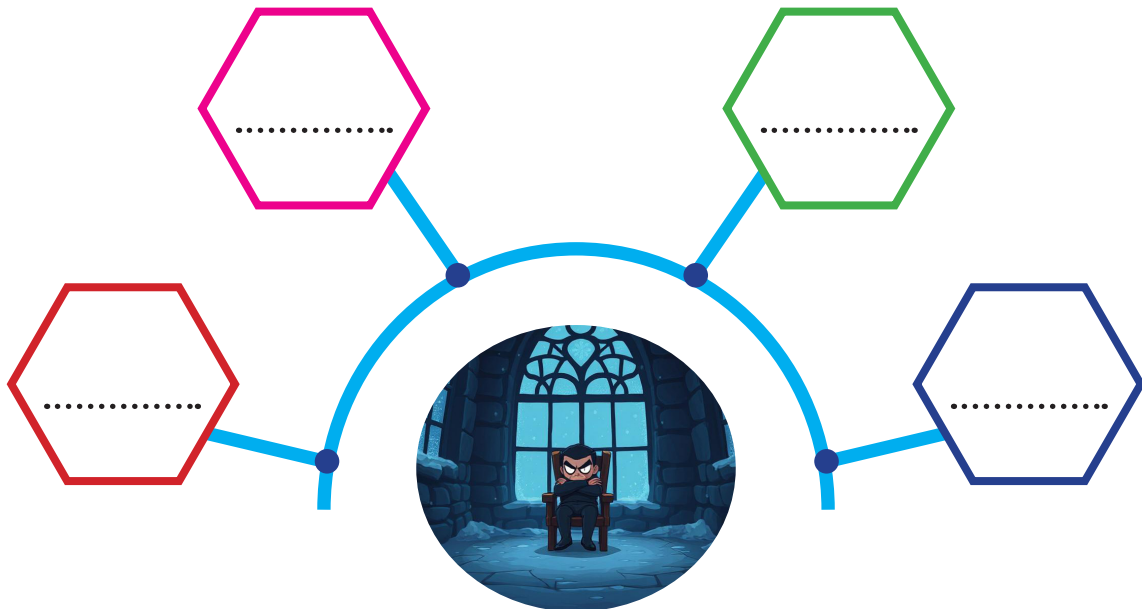
The villain tried to spoil Christmas. Re-arrange the sentences to complete the story map and know what happens in the story.

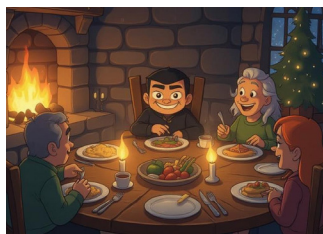
