### Stage Performance



#### Introduction

When people perform on stage, it is important for everyone to be respectful so the show is enjoyable for all.

The **audience** should:

- watch the show quietly and attentively.
- avoid talking or making loud noises, and allow everyone to enjoy the performance without distractions.



**Performers** should also behave respectfully on stage. They should be:

- well-prepared
- arrive on time
- show appreciation for the audience
- Showing confidence

When both **performers and audience members** show respect and behave appropriately, the performance becomes a positive and memorable experience for everyone involved.

  - Be prepared and focused.
  - Enter and leave the performance area calmly.

  - Remain quiet and attentive throughout the performance.
  - Avoid talking or making noises.
  - Clap politely at the end of each performance.
