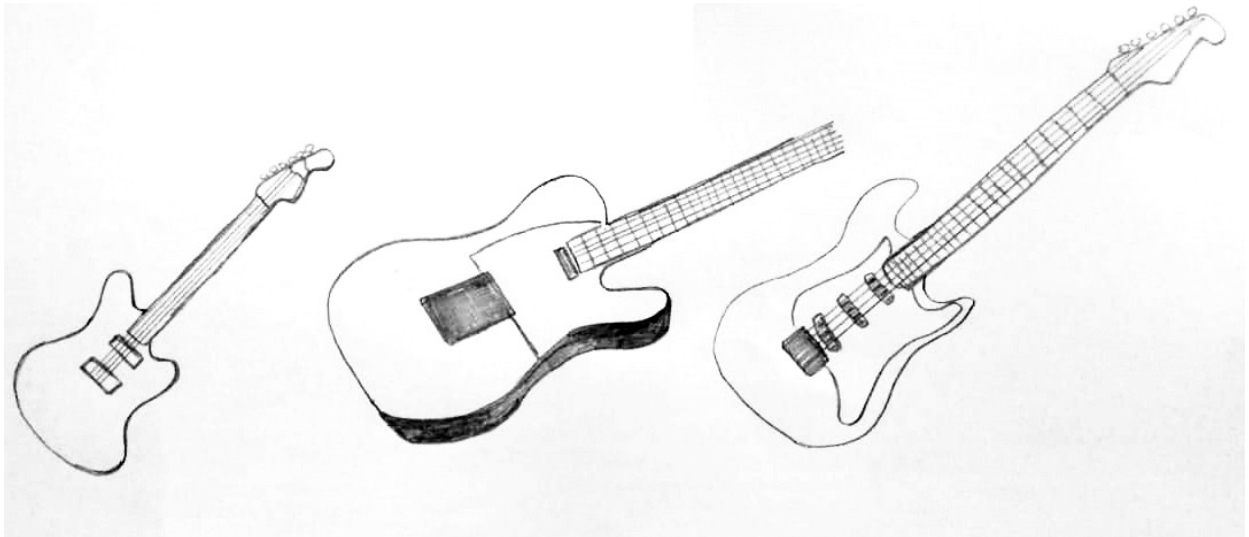

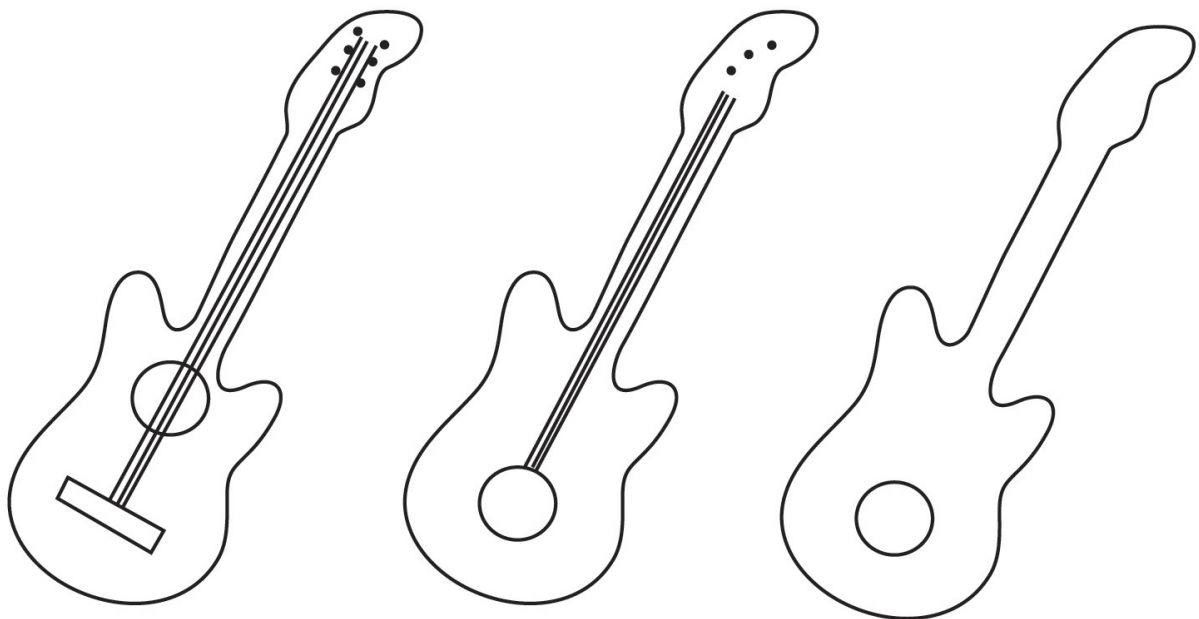
Student's Worksheets: GRADE 8 Lesson 7

Apply block printing to create motifs and patterns

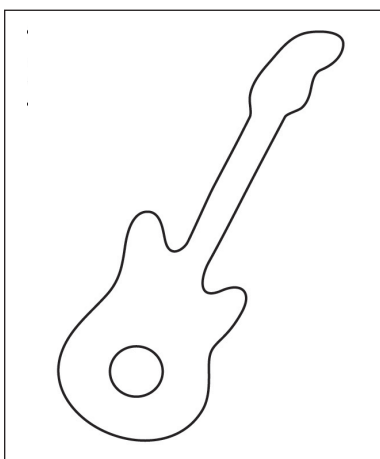
1. Select and draw a musical instrument of your choice from the worksheet or from your research.



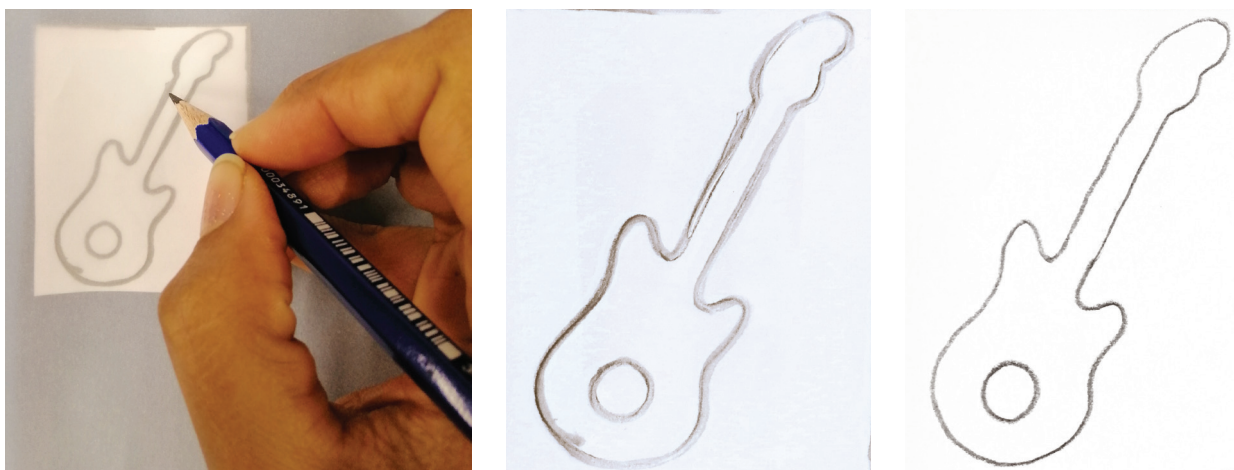
2. Use the stylization process to create a motif from the linear drawing. A simple and stylised motif is obtained by reducing an image's realistic features.



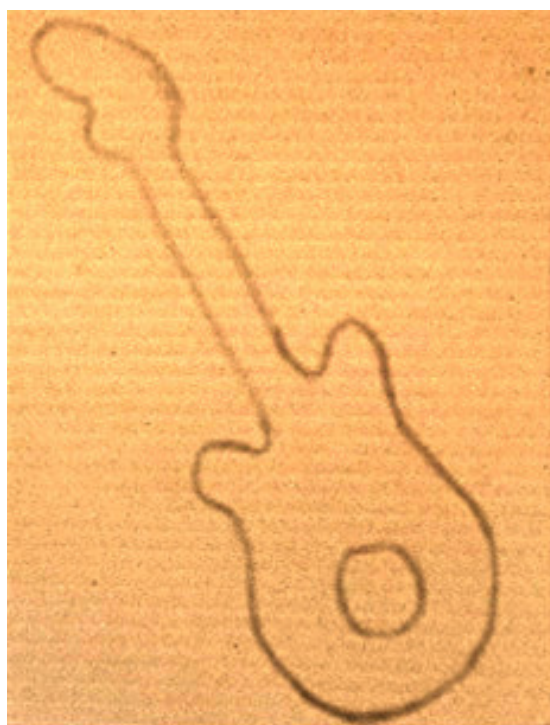
3. Draw the motif within a rectangle of dimension 5 x 6 cm.



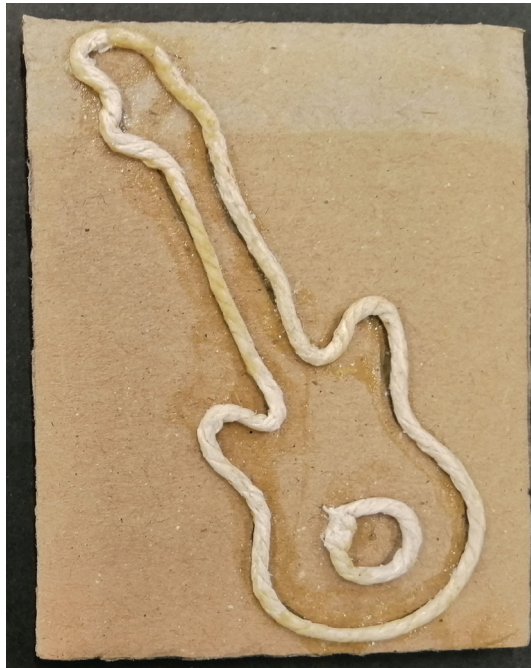
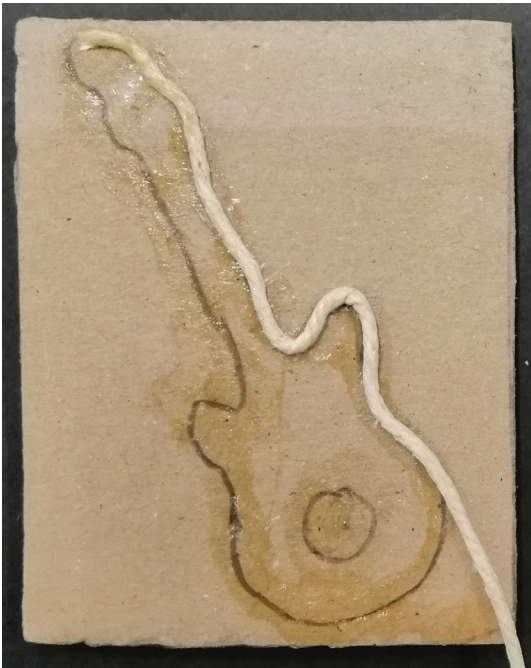
4. Place the tracing paper on the selected motif and trace it out using a dark toned pencil.



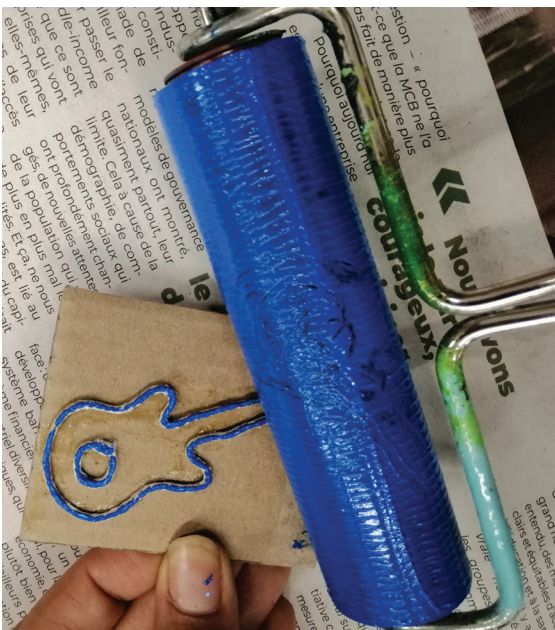
5. Apply a dark toned pencil on the visible drawing on the reverse. Then, use the tracing paper to transfer the motif on a cardboard of dimension 5 x 6 cm.



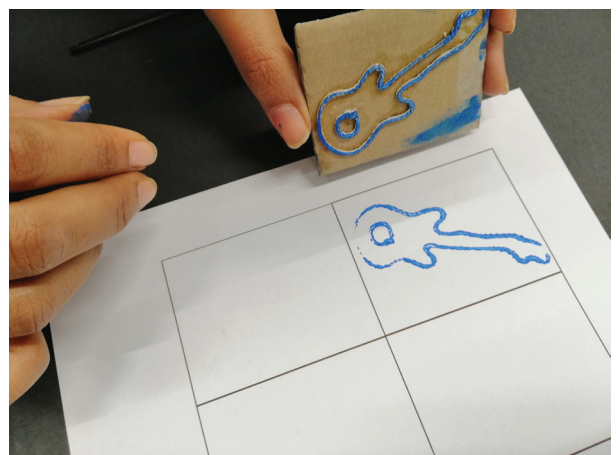
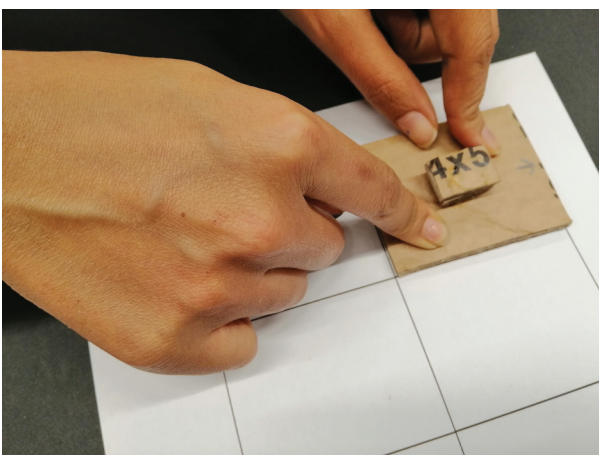
6. Glue the string onto the outline of the motif.



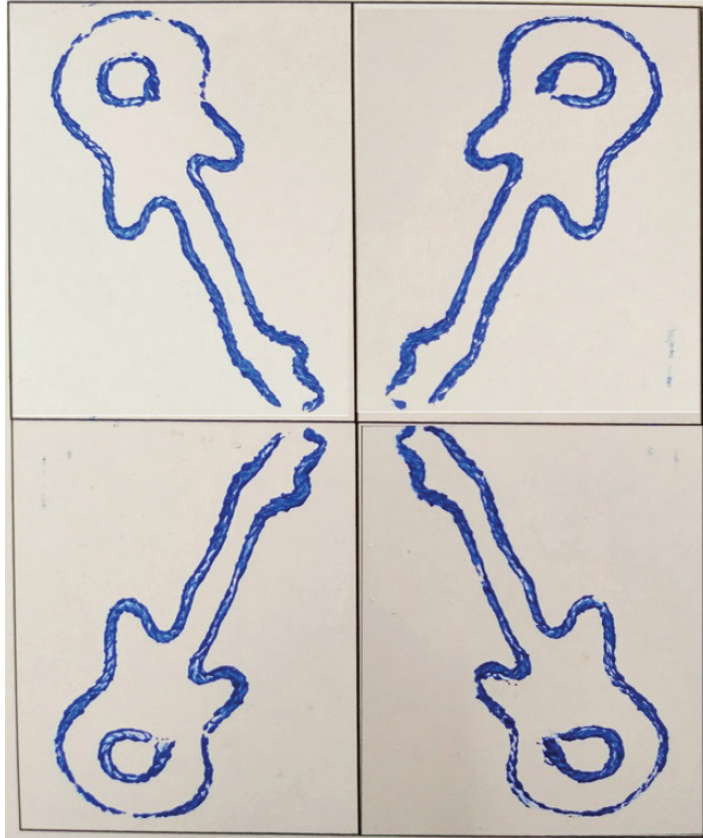
7. Apply paint onto the relief block using a roller or a paintbrush.



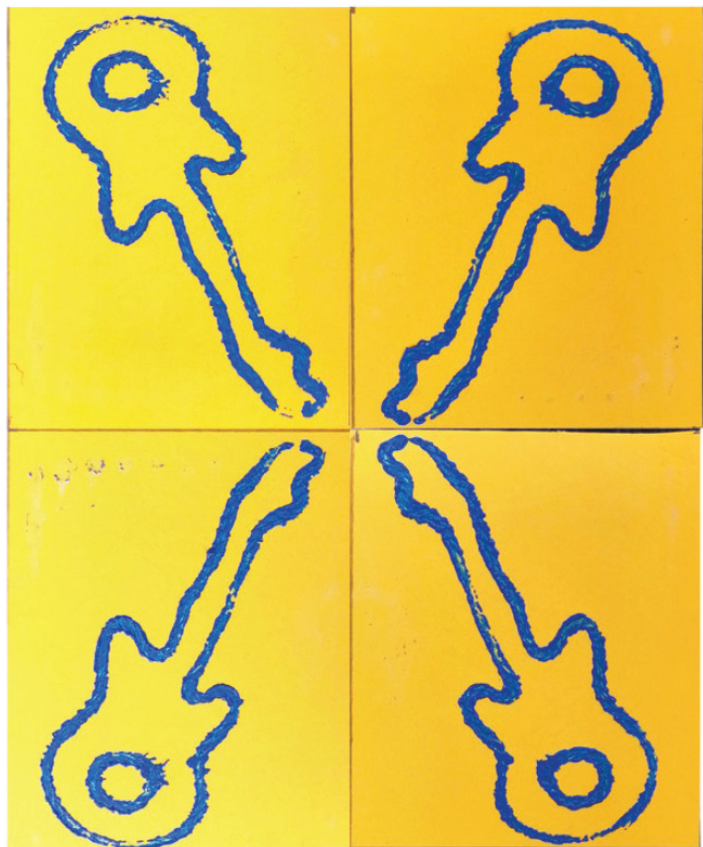
8. Carefully place the block, apply pressure and lift carefully to obtain a print.



9. Use the block to create a repeat pattern using string printing technique.
