Instructions to the smart shoppers:

1. Select your first supermarket catalogue.
2. Search for each item on the shopping list.
3. Insert the price for each item in the column for Supermarket 1
4. Repeat the above procedure for Supermarkets 2 and 3.
5. Select the price for the goods you want to buy either from Supermarket 1, 2 or 3. Write your chosen price in the column "Chosen Supermarket."
6. Add the price (using a calculator) for all chosen items in the row "Total cost."
7. Take the budgeted amount of Rs.2000 and subtract the total cost of your chosen products from Supermarket 1, 2 or 3.
8. Discuss with your teacher what you would like to do with the amount of money you have saved.
