Teacher's Guide: GRADE 7 - Lesson 2 Birthday

Birthday

Competency: Reading with comprehension, Vocabulary and Sentence Structure

Element: Comprehend age-appropriate Arabic sentences, Use given Arabic words to complete simple sentences

Performance Criteria:

- Read and understand simple Arabic sentences,
- Understand how words fit together to form meaningful sentences

Purpose of Activity:

To enable students to read, complete, and write simple birthday-related words, through reading comprehension, fill-in-the-blank task, and vocabulary identification in context.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- Read simple Arabic birthday-related sentences
- Recognise vocabulary in context and answer short comprehension questions

Teaching trajectories/ Implementation guidelines:

Activity 1:

Reading and Responding (Comprehension questions)

- 1. Briefly review key birthday vocabulary using visuals
- 2. Ask students simple oral questions to engage them
- 3. Distribute worksheet
- 4. Read each sentence aloud slowly while students follow along
- 5. Ask students to read each sentence aloud individually or in pairs
- 6. Ask students to answer simple Arabic wh-questions

Activity 2:

Fill in the Blanks

- 1. Review the gender of common nouns using birthday-themed images
- 2. Briefly revise subject pronouns
- 3. Show one sentence from the worksheet on the board with a missing word
- 4. Model how to choose the correct word
- 5. Students read the full sentence in their worksheet
- 6. They select the correct word from the given words and write it in the blank
- 7. Encourage them to read the full sentence aloud after completing each item

Activity 3:

Find the word in the sentence

- 1. Write the first sentence on the board
- 2. Say the target word (birthday related word) and demonstrate how to locate and circle it
- 3. Model the follow up action (e.g., drawing the cake on the table)
- 4. Read the next sentence aloud and guide learners to identify and circle the word
- 5. Translate the sentence aloud with support
- 6. Students complete the remaining sentences independently, following the same process

Resources and materials:

Student worksheets, visual aids(image flashcards of birthday items, coloured pencils)

Assessment:

Reading:

Can students correctly read and understand familiar birthday related sentences and vocabulary in context?

Vocabulary:

Can students identify and locate target words in full sentences and respond appropriately?

Extension of activity:

Sentence swap challenge

Students write one sentence using birthday vocabulary.

They swap with a friend, who must correct any errors and read it aloud.
