Teacher's Guide: GRADE 7 - Lesson 3 Birthday

## **Birthday**

Competency: Writing Readiness, Engage in simple conversation

**Element:** Write familiar words and simple sentences, Engage in simple conversation

#### **Performance Criteria:**

- Write words and simple phrases using modelled structures
- Use common words orally in simple sentences

### **Purpose of Activity:**

To enable students to apply known vocabulary and sentence structures to form meaningful Arabic sentences related to birthdays, through oral exchanges, reordering, sentence completion and guided writing.

### **Learning Outcomes:**

By the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- Identify key-birthday-related vocabulary and use them in writing
- Use labelled vocabulary in short guided oral exchanges to describe objects and respond to simple questions
- Complete sentence with appropriate words using gender and context clues
- Compose short, structured sentences using modelled examples

# FPNLS: ARABIC - Teacher's Guide GRADE 7 - Lesson 3 Birthday

### **Teaching trajectories/ Implementation guidelines:**

#### **Activity 1:**

#### **Label and Conversation**

- 1. Display the birthday scene with familiar items
- 2. Ask students to label the objects with the words given
- 3. In pairs, students use their labels to build short oral exchanges
- 4. Support with sentence frames and vocabulary posters

### **Activity 2:**

### **Sentence Reordering**

- 1. Provide jumbled words for 3-4 simple birthday related sentences
- 2. Model reordering one sentence with the class
- 3. Students reorder the rest independently
- 4. Teacher checks responses, highlighting sentence structure patterns

### **Activity 3:**

### Sentence completion

- 1. Students complete partially written sentences using a word bank
- 2. Emphasise gender agreement and meaning
- 3. Optionally, ask students to draw a small image matching the sentence content
- 4. In pairs, students read their completed sentences aloud to each other

#### **Assessment:**

**Writing:** Can the students correctly complete each sentence using the appropriate vocabulary?

**Grammar:** Do the students apply correct gender agreement and sentence structure?

**Vocabulary:** Can the students choose the right word based on sentence context and meaning?

### **Extension of activity:**

### **Partner Sentence Challenge**

Student swap worksheets with a partner and read each other's completed sentences.

Each partner checks for word choice, gender agreement and meaning.
