Teacher's Guide: GRADE 8 - Lesson 1 Eid Ul Fitr

## Eid Ul Fitr

**Competency:** Listening with understanding

**Element:** Understand basic spoken Arabic words

**Performance Criteria:**

- Listen to and understand meaning of common words

**Purpose of Activity:**

To develop students' listening and recognition skills in Arabic by identifying thematic vocabulary and phrases on Eid-ul-Fitr through spoken instructions, repetition and matching tasks.

**Learning Outcomes:**

By the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- Recognise and repeat familiar vocabulary on Eid-ul-Fitr in Arabic
- Listen and repeat Arabic phrases on Eid-ul-fitr
- Match words to form meaningful sentences
- Demonstrate understanding through picture description

## Teaching trajectories/ Implementation guidelines:

### Activity 1:

#### Listen and repeat

1. Show images of new vocabulary and pronounce each clearly
2. Ask students to repeat the name orally
3. Check recognition by asking ما هذا / ما هذه ؟

### Activity 2:

#### Listen and repeat

1. Read sentences aloud and show corresponding pictures
2. Students listen and repeat the sentences with correct pronunciation and intonation
3. Read sentences at random and ask students to locate the correct illustrations
4. Show pictures and ask students to describe briefly

### Activity 3:

#### Matching

1. Read the groups of words aloud
2. Students draw lines to match the group of words forming meaningful sentences
3. Reinforce through peer review and class discussion

## Resources and materials:

Worksheets with pictures

## Assessment:

**Vocabulary:** Can students identify the new vocabularies based on spoken instructions?

**Listening:** Can students understand spoken description of Eid-ul-fitr celebration?

**Speaking:** Can students describe pictures illustrating Eid-ul-fitr?

**Reading:** Can students form short phrases by matching words?

## Extension of activity:

Students use new vocabularies and phrases to describe 'Eid-ul-fitr' orally.
