Teacher's Guide: GRADE 9 - Lesson 1 Wedding

Wedding

Competency: Listening and speaking with understanding

Element: Understand the vocabularies related to the topic.

Respond to simple oral instructions and questions.

Use simple oral courtesies.

Performance Criteria:

- Understand and interpret spoken information.
- Comprehend the meaning of questions and identify key details.
- Use words of courtesy and greetings appropriately.

Purpose of Activity:

To enable students to recognize, pronounce and understand vocabularies related to wedding in Arabic through listening, oral repetition and roleplay.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- Recognize spoken Arabic words related to wedding celebration.
- To understand the spoken Arabic words.
- To read and understand Arabic sentences related to wedding celebrations.
- To identify the different interrogative pronouns.
- To make use of learned vocabularies in sentences.
- To develop the listening and speaking skills.

Teaching trajectories/ Implementation guidelines:

Activity 1:

Observe, listen and repeat

- 1. Display the vocabulary sheet with pictures and words.
- 2. Teacher asks the student to observe the pictures and asks questions related to the pictures.
- 3. Teacher reads aloud the vocabularies and students listen and repeat afterwards.

Activity 2:

Roleplay

- 1. Teacher reads aloud the conversation and students listen carefully.
- 2. Teacher explains the meaning of vocabularies.
- 3. Teacher asks two students to come in front of the class and do the roleplay.

Activity 3:

Filling the blanks with appropriate vocabularies.

- 1. Teacher reads aloud the vocabularies and students repeat the words.
- 2. Teacher reads and explains the sentences.
- 3. Teacher asks the students to look for the appropriate vocabulary and write it in the blank space.
