Teacher's Guide: GRADE 9 - Lesson 3 Wedding

Wedding

Competency: Writing

Element: Write basic level- appropriate words and phrases.

Performance Criteria:

- Write simple words and familiar sentences through dictation
- Write accurately age- appropriate words using spelling strategies.
- Write simple phrases correctly to describe pictures and answer questions.

Purpose of Activity:

To enable students to recognize vocabularies related to the topic and write sentences using the vocabularies learnt through scaffolding, questionings and explanation.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- To identify and to spell the vocabularies correctly.
- To observe and write meaningful sentences based on the pictures
- To make use of learned vocabularies in sentences.

Teaching trajectories/ Implementation guidelines:

Activity 1:

Place the following words at the right place

1. Teacher asks the students to observe the picture.
2. Teacher asks the students to write the wedding related vocabulary in the space provided.
3. Allow students to refer to previous worksheets as support.

Activity 2:

Observe the above picture and write sentences on the picture, you may find the following questions useful for this exercise.

1. Teacher asks the students to observe the picture.
2. Teacher reads the questions and explains it to them.
3. Teacher reads the vocabularies given and help the students to answer the questions and ask them to write its answers in their copybook.

Activity 3:

Write meaningful sentences with the following vocabularies:

1. The teacher reads and explains the vocabularies.
2. The teacher writes some useful vocabularies on the whiteboard.
3. The teacher asks the students to write sentences with the vocabularies.

Resources and materials:

Assessment:

Writing: Test students' ability to write sentences after picture observation.

Test students' ability to write and express themselves in writing.

Extension of activity:

Students may write additional sentences with selected vocabularies.
