**Lesson 5: Sewing tools and pressing equipment** 



Four class periods (35 minutes each)





#### Competency 2.2:

 Apply safety precautions while using basic sewing tools and equipment.



#### Purpose of activities:

 The activities will help students learn how to use basic sewing tools and equipment safely.



#### Learning outcomes:

By the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- 1. Identify basic sewing tools and pressing equipment.
- 2. Use basic sewing tools safely.
- Apply safety precautions when using the electric sewing machine and pressing equipment.



#### Teaching trajectories/Implementation guidelines



#### Activity 1: Introduction to basic sewing tools and equipment.

Materials needed:

- Needle, pin
- Thimble
- Tailor's chalk
- Measuring tape
- Fabric scissors
- Unpicker
- Electric sewing machine
- Steam iron
- Ironing table



#### Note to Educator

Tools are small items used to measure, cut and sew fabrics.

Equipment are larger than tools that help to complete tasks more efficiently, such as electric sewing machine, iron and ironing board.



#### 1. Introduce the lesson

- Display the sewing tools and pressing equipment.
- · State the name of each.
- Demonstrate the use of each.



# Activity 2: Safety rules and storage of basic sewing tools and equipment.

Educators are required to explain the following:

- Avoid putting needle and pins in the mouth when sewing.
- Always store needles and pins in a box or pin cushion.
- Avoid running with scissors.
- · Keep scissors closed when not in use.
- Always hand over scissors by holding the blades.
- Apply safety measures when using the sewing machine:
  - o Keep fingers away from the needle.
  - o Turn off the machine after use.
  - o Do not use with wet hands.
- Apply safety measures when using the iron:
  - o Keep fingers away from the hot plate.
  - o Always rest the iron in an upright position.
  - o Switch off iron after use.



#### **Activity 3: Using basic sewing tools safely.**

Materials needed:

- Needle, thread
- Measuring tape
- Tailor's chalk/fabric pen
- Scissors
- Calico fabric (50 cm).


#### Instructions:

Educators are required to:

- a) Demonstrate how to measure and mark the fabric:
  - o Lay out the calico fabric flat on the table.
  - o Use the measuring tape to measure 20cm x 20cm.
  - o Use tailor's chalk/fabric pen to draw a square on the fabric.



- b) Demonstrate how to cut the fabric:
  - o Use fabric scissors to cut along the marked lines.
  - o Remind students to keep fingers away from the blades and not to rush while cutting.
- c) Demonstrate how to thread a needle:
  - o Show how to single thread a needle.
  - o Show how to double thread a needle.



d) Emphasise upon safety during each step.



#### Note

**Use a single thread** for sewing lightweight to medium weight fabrics - for neat and decorative stitches.

**Use a double thread** for heavy weight fabrics, sewing buttons or repairs, and when you need strong, durable stitches.

1. Always store needles and pins in a box or pin cushion.



2. Avoid running with scissors.



3. Turn off the iron after use.



4. We use an **iron** for ironing clothes.



5. The iron must be kept on its **heel** when not in use.



6. Be careful when using the hot iron so you do not **burn** your hand.



7. Always keep the **sewing** machine switched off, when not in use.



8. Always keep your **fingers** away from the needle when using the sewing machine.





Worksheet for Activity 3: Using basic sewing tools safely Perform the following tasks while observing all safety rules.


- 1. Measure and mark the fabric: insert icon measure.
  - o Use a measuring tape to measure a square of 20cm x 20cm on your fabric.
  - o Use tailor's chalk to draw the square neatly.



#### 2. Cut the fabric:


- o Use fabric scissors to cut along the marked lines.
- o Make sure to cut slowly and safely, keeping fingers away from the blades.





#### 3. Thread a needle:

- o Single thread a needle.
- o Double thread a needle.
- o Allow students to try to thread the needle using sewing thread and cotton perlé/ embroidery thread- they will observe that different needles will be required according to the type of thread used.
