# Minimum Admission Requirements:

(1) A Cambridge School Certificate with Credit in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings;

#### Or

Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level", provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either-

- (i) in 5 subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any 2 subjects; or
- (ii) in 6 subjects, including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject.
- (2) A Cambridge Higher School Certificate or General Certificate of Education 'Advanced level' obtained at one sitting with 2 subjects at 'A' level.

### OR

Equivalent qualifications to (1) and (2) above acceptable to the MIE

(3) A Degree or joint Degree relevant to the Main Field of Study.

### Minimum Admission Requirement:

(1) A Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least 5 subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings;

or

Passes not below Grade C in at least 5 subjects including English Language obtained at not more than 2 sittings at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level".

(2) A Cambridge Higher School Certificate or Passes in at least 2 subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education 'Advanced Level'.

### <u>OR</u>

Equivalent qualifications to (1) and (2) above acceptable to the MIE

### Note:

- Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at "Principal Level" and one subject at "Subsidiary Level" as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.
- At least one subject at 'A' Level should be relevant to the Main Field of Study applied for except for Physical Education, Kreol Repiblik Moris, Food Studies, Design and Textiles Studies, History and Geography.
- Candidates are required to have at least a grade "C" at "A" Level in their respective field of study applied.
- For Food Studies, an 'A' Level in any Science subject (Biology, Chemistry or Physics) could also be considered relevant.
- For Design & Textiles Studies, an 'A' Level in Art & Design, Design and Technology or Chemistry could also be considered relevant.
- For Kreol Repiblik Moris, candidates should have at least one subject in Languages at 'A' level.
- For Physical Education, History and Geography, candidates should have at least a grade 'C' in one of the subjects at 'A' level.

**Duration of Course:** Three Years (6 Semesters)

### Note:

- Specialised Room / Laboratory Fee is applicable for Art and Design, Computer Science, Design and Technology, Design and Textiles Studies, Food Studies, Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Physical Education.
- The Tuition Fee amounting to Rs 15,000 per semester will be paid by government for those candidates attempting a Full-Time undergraduate degree for the first time, in line with the government policy pertaining to Free Tertiary Education Scheme (Ref: MTE/CR/198). However, those who already possess a degree will be required to pay the tuition fee.

(1) A Cambridge School Certificate with Credit in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings;

#### Or

Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level", provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either-

- (i) in 5 subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any 2 subjects; or
- (ii) in 6 subjects, including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject.
- (2) A Cambridge Higher School Certificate or General Certificate of Education 'Advanced level' obtained at one sitting with 2 subjects at 'A' level.

### <u>OR</u>

Equivalent qualifications to (1) and (2) above acceptable to the MIE

(3) A Degree or joint Degree relevant to the Main Field of Study.

**Note**: For practising educators, qualifications at (1), and (2) will not apply.

The PGCE programme is open to:

- (i). Applicants in a teaching position at secondary school level wishing to complete a professional qualification;
- (ii). Applicants in a teaching position seeking to move to a secondary school teaching position on the strength of a university degree; and
- (iii). Suitably qualified applicants in non-teaching employment positions but aspiring to take up a teaching role in secondary schools.

**Note**: Candidates already in employment should submit an original Testimonial from their respective employer at the time of registration, specifying that they will be granted release to attend the PGCE (Part Time) programme.

**Duration of Course:** One-and-a-half Year (3 Semesters)

# 2. EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION – TEACHER'S CERTIFICATE (ECETC)

This programme is meant for In-Service Educators practising in Pre-Primary Schools.

# Minimum Admission Requirements:

- (i) Five passes at SC/GCE 'O' level including English, French & Mathematics or acceptable alternative qualifications.
- (ii) At least 1 year of proven practice in a registered early childhood setting.

**Duration of Course:** 2 Years (4 semesters)

# Yearly Fee:

1. Registration Fee: Rs 1000

2. Library Fee: Rs 500

3. IT Fee: Rs 500

4. Student Union Fee: Rs 50

### Note:

- Applicants should have adequate access to an early childhood setting throughout the duration of the programme.
- Students will be required to obtain a First Aid Certificate from a certified provider identified by the MIE against payment of a fee as prescribed by the service provider.

### 3. CERTIFICATE IN SPECIAL EDUCATION (CSE)

This programme is meant for Educators or Assistant Educators working in Special Education Needs Institutions and specialised schools in Mauritius.

# Minimum Admission Requirements:

A Cambridge School Certificate / GCE 'O' level, with a minimum of 2 years SEN experience.

**Duration of Course:** 2 Years (4 semesters)

Yearly Fees: Rs 2,050, including:

1. Registration Fee: Rs 1,000

2. Library Fee: Rs 500

3. IT Fee: Rs 500

4. Students' Union Fee: Rs 50

### Note:

- Applicants should have adequate access to a SEN setting throughout the duration of the programme.
- Classes are run twice weekly. Candidates should ensure that they will be released for attending classes at the MIE on at least one full day during the week.

### Programme Delivery at the MIE:

- Full-Time courses are normally run from 09 00 to 16 00 on weekdays and 09 00 to noon on Saturdays. Students may also be required to follow courses from 16 00 to 19 00 during weekdays and on Saturday afternoons.
- Part-Time courses are normally run from 16 00 to 19 00 during weekdays and from 09 00 to Noon on Saturdays. Students may also be required to follow courses on Saturday afternoons.
- Courses may be offered face-to-face, online, on a distance mode or on a split basis, or with a combination of any of those modalities. As such, students should make the necessary arrangements for personal device and Internet connectivity, and ensure that they conduct all the activities as specified in the Programme Handbook and Module Information Sheets provided by the tutors.
- The MIE may resort to an online mode during bad weather conditions or in conditions that could hinder the normal face-to-face mode of delivery.
- The MIE reserves the right to make any further alteration to the duration of the programme, mode of delivery and assessment owing to any exigency that may occur in the future.

#### **General Notes:**

- (a) Online Applications should bear all relevant details as per the stipulated entry requirements since selection will be based solely on information provided online.
- (b) Qualifications obtained after the closing date will not be considered.
- (c) The best qualified candidates will be selected for the above programmes.
- (d) The onus for the submission of equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from relevant authorities in Mauritius (HEC or MQA) rests solely on the candidate.
- (e) Courses will be run subject to a critical mass being obtained in the respective courses.
- (f) Candidates are allowed to follow only one course at a time at the MIE.
- (g) Only successful applicants will be notified of the outcome of their applications.
- (h) The MIE reserves the right not to run any of the above-mentioned programmes nor will it assign any reason thereof.
- (i) Candidates may apply for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) as an alternative route for entry in any of the programmes on offer in line with the MIE RPL Policy.

- Once the applications are submitted, the **Declaration Form** has to be printed and signed to certify acceptance of the Terms and Conditions stipulated in the programme.
- The form should be sent to the Office of the Registrar, MIE, Réduit, at latest by Saturday 03 January 2026 at 15 00.
- The course applied for should be clearly indicated at the top left-hand corner of the envelope.
- Applications not received as per the modality described above will not be considered.
