FULL-TIME PROGRAMME

1. POST GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN EDUCATION (PGCE) PRE-SERVICE

This programme is meant for pre-service candidates in Mauritius.

Minimum Admission Requirements:

- (1) A Cambridge School Certificate with Credit in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings;

Or

Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level”, provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either-

- (i) in 5 subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any 2 subjects;
or
(ii) in 6 subjects, including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject.

- (2) A Cambridge Higher School Certificate or General Certificate of Education ‘Advanced level’ obtained at one sitting with 2 subjects at ‘A’ level.

OR

Equivalent qualifications to (1) and (2) above acceptable to the MIE

- (3) A Degree or joint Degree relevant to the Main Field of Study.

Note:

- Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at “Principal Level” and one subject at “Subsidiary Level” as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

Duration of Course: One Year (2 Semesters)

Fees payable at the time of registration: Rs. 13,050 including the following fees:

- Registration Fee (*per semester*): Rs. 12,000
- Library Fee (*per year*): Rs. 500
- IT Fee (*per year*): Rs. 500
- Students’ Union Fee (*per year*): Rs. 50

Total Course Fees: Rs. 25,050

PART-TIME PROGRAMMES

1. BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (Honours) in Technical and Vocational Education and Training - B.Ed (Hons) TVET

This programme is meant for in-service Instructors / Teachers / Lecturers working in the Vocational sector in Mauritius and Rodrigues.

Minimum Admission Requirements:

Candidates are required to possess any of the following qualifications:

- A Cambridge Higher School Certificate (HSC) or Passes in at least 2 subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level”
- A Diploma in an Educational / Vocational field from a recognised institution PLUS at least 5 years of teaching experience in a recognised Vocational Institution
- A Degree or joint Degree in the relevant subject area acceptable to the MIE

Duration of Course: 3 Years (6 Semesters)

Fees payable at the time of registration: Rs. 25,050 *including the following fees:*

| • Administrative Fee (<i>per year</i>): | Rs. 3,500 |
| • Specialised Room / Laboratory Fee (<i>per year</i>): | Rs. 3,000 |

2. CERTIFICATE IN SPECIAL EDUCATION (CSE)

This programme is meant for Assistant Teachers working in Special Education Needs (SEN) institutions and specialised schools in Mauritius.

Minimum Admission Requirement:

- (i). 5 passes at O-Level including English, French and Mathematics.
- (ii). At least 2 years of teaching experience in Special Education Needs (SEN).

Duration of Course: 2 Years (4 Semesters)

Fees payable at the time of registration: Rs. 5,050 *including the following yearly fees:*

- Registration Fee: Rs. 4,000
- Library Fee: Rs. 500
- IT Fee: Rs. 500
- Students' Union Fee: Rs. 50

Total Course Fees: Rs. 10,100

Note:

- Applicants should have adequate access to a SEN setting throughout the duration of the programme.
- Classes are run twice weekly from 15:30 hrs to 18:30 hrs and on Saturday from 09:00 hrs to Noon.

3. CERTIFICATE IN EDUCATIONAL MANAGEMENT IN EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION (CEMECE)

This programme is meant for Managers and Assistant Managers working in Pre-Primary Schools in Mauritius.

Minimum Admission Requirement:

Candidates are required to possess any of the following qualifications:

- A Teacher's Certificate Pre-Primary (TCPP) / Teacher's Certificate in Early Childhood Education (TCECE) / Early Childhood Education – Teacher's Certificate (ECETC) from the MIE.

OR

- A Recognition in Prior Learning for a Certificate in Educational Management in Early Childhood Education (RPL CEMECE) from the MIE.

Duration of Course: 1½ Years (3 Semesters)

Total course fees payable at the time of registration: Rs. 5,050 including the following:

- Registration Fee: Rs. 4,000
- Library Fee: Rs. 500
- IT Fee: Rs. 500
- Students' Union Fee: Rs. 50

Programme Delivery at the MIE:

- *Full-Time courses are normally run from 09 00 to 16 00 on weekdays and 09 00 to noon on Saturdays. Students may also be required to follow courses from 16 00 to 19 00 during weekdays and on Saturday afternoons.*
- *Part-Time courses are normally run from 16 00 to 19 00 during weekdays and from 09 00 to Noon on Saturdays. Students may also be required to follow courses on Saturday afternoons.*
- *Courses may be offered face-to-face, online, on a distance mode or on a split basis, or with a combination of any of those modalities. As such, students should make the necessary arrangements for personal device and Internet connectivity and ensure that they conduct all the activities as specified in the Programme Handbook and Module Information Sheets provided by the tutors.*
- *The MIE may resort to an online mode during bad weather conditions or in conditions that could hinder the normal face-to-face mode of delivery.*
- *The MIE reserves the right to alter the duration of the programme, mode of delivery and assessment owing to any exigency that may occur in the future.*

General Notes:

- (a) Online applications should bear all relevant details as per the stipulated entry requirements since selection will be based solely on information provided online.*
- (b) Qualifications obtained after the closing date will not be considered.*
- (c) The onus for the submission of equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from relevant authorities in Mauritius (HEC or MQA) rests solely on the candidate, bearing his / her name.*
- (d) Courses will be run subject to a critical mass being obtained in the respective courses.*
- (e) Candidates are allowed to follow only one course at a time at the MIE.*
- (f) Only successful applicants will be notified of the outcome of their applications.*
- (g) The MIE reserves the right not to run any of the above-mentioned programmes nor will it assign any reason thereof.*
- (h) Candidates may apply for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) as an alternative route for entry in any of the programmes on offer in line with the MIE RPL Policy.*

- Once the applications are submitted, the **Declaration Form** has to be printed and signed to certify acceptance of the Terms and Conditions stipulated in the programme.
- The form should be sent to the **Office of the Registrar, MIE, Réduit**, at latest by **Friday 17 July 2026 at 15:00 hrs.**
- The course applied for should be clearly indicated at the top left-hand corner of the envelope.
- Applications not received as per the modality described above will not be considered.
