



MA Education Programme (Intake September 2026) Mauritius and Rodrigues

The MIE is pleased to offer **the MA Education programme** in collaboration with St Mary's University. St Mary's University has a long experience in providing high quality professional development programmes in education and ranks in the Top 10 for Teaching Quality in the UK (The Times Good University Guide, 2025) and is 2nd for Academic Support in London (National Student Survey, 2025).

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for enrolment on the above programme. The MA Education is a fee-paying, one-year part-time programme, taught fully online and is scheduled to start in September 2026.

Minimum Admission Requirements:

- (i) A relevant degree or equivalent qualifications acceptable to the MIE;
- (ii) A PGDip (Ed) qualification or equivalent qualifications acceptable to the MIE; and
- (iii) Evidence of current relevant experience in the field of education.

Note:

- (b) Students applying for the MA Education programme can opt **EITHER** for the general MA Education programme **OR** for **ONE** of these areas of **specialisation**:
 - (i) Leadership and Management;
 - (ii) Learning and Teaching in Higher Education;
 - (iii) Mentoring, Coaching and Supervision and;
 - (iv) Quality Assurance.

£3550 (subject to an annual increase not exceeding 5%), payable in up to 5 equal instalments (in September 2026, November 2026, January 2027, April 2027 and June 2027)
